Create a Qlik Account

Create a Qlik account by visiting [register for qlik.com](https://register.for.qlik.com) and follow the instructions below.

NOTE! All professors and students must use the same university name and must use their university email address. Using any other name and email address will prohibit your download and acceptance into the Academic Program group in QlikCommunity.
