Jira issue ID: NP-427

Qlik NPrinting 16.6 officially supports QlikView 11.20 SR16.

Support for QlikView 12.10 SR4

Jira issue ID: NP-426

Qlik NPrinting 16.6 officially supports QlikView 12.10 SR4.

Bug fixes

Images exported from QlikView are truncated or have excess padding

Jira issue ID: NP-147

Images exported from QlikView sheets were sometimes truncated or gained unnecessary white padding. To receive this fix you must use QlikView 12.10 SR1 or higher.

Reports based on Excel templates ignore custom row heights

Jira issue ID: NP-379

In Excel templates, row heights set in template editor with the **Keep Source Formats** check box unflagged were ignored. Row heights changed in the template file are now kept in the output report.

PDF reports generated from PowerPoint templates fail to generate completely

Jira issue ID: NP-398

In Qlik NPrinting 16.5, PDF reports built using PowerPoint templates would intermittently fail to generate completely. This issue does not exist in previous versions of Qlik NPrinting.

PDF reports generated from PowerPoint templates ignore distributed alignment setting

Jira issue ID: NP-272

The **Paragraph > Alignment > Distributed** setting did not work with PDF reports generated from PowerPoint templates.

Unable to add filters to New Recipient or Group

Jira issue ID: NP-291

Under **Task > Report Task > Recipient**, you can create a New Recipient, a Custom Recipient, or a Group. In previous versions, you could also apply filters, but only to a Custom Recipient. It is now possible to apply filters to all three types of Recipient.

PDF reports generated from Word templates rotate Japanese text by 45 degrees

Jira issue ID: NP-308

PDF reports generated from Word templates would incorrectly rotate Japanese text 45 degrees.

Word and PowerPoint templates containing QlikView tables do not maintain border formatting

Jira issue ID: NP-331

QlikView straight tables used in Word and PowerPoint templates did not maintain original border formatting.

PowerPoint report tables contain unexpected white padding

Jira issue ID: NP-350

PowerPoint reports created using PowerPoint templates had unexpected white padding in the first cell of straight tables. Previous versions are not affected.

Excessive log file creation

Jira issue ID: NP-387

When more than seven .nsq files were stored in a Network-attached storage (NAS) drive, log files would be created at an exponential rate.

Excel reports align images incorrectly if cell height is non-standard

Jira issue ID: NP-401

In Excel reports, images were misaligned if blank cell height was different from tag cell height. Images now automatically align to the top of cells.

Filter removed from the original recipient when removed from the clone

Jira issue ID: NP-276

If you created a recipient with a filter created within it, you cloned the recipient and after delete the filter from the clone, the filter was removed also from the original recipient. The original recipient was not modified if filter was created from the filter tab and was removed from the clone.
