

1. The report definition showing the dynamic name with the variable.





4. The Publish Task Report detail screen showing the default Friendly Name which was automatically set to the report name as soon as it was chosen.




5. The Report named as displayed on NewsStand


6. The downloaded zip showing the variable substitution




7. I attempted to add the variable as shown on the report definition screen to the Friendly Name as shown below.


