

Differentiating Prod and Dev Environments

Differently from QlikView, Qlik Sense applications are developed on the browser which means that identifying applications based on the interface becomes tricky. The configurations documented here were done to provide clear differentiation between Prod and Dev environments and do not affect the application, they have effect only on the environment. So, the application can be moved from Dev to Prod without any particular change on it.



These configurations are applied ONLY to the Qlik Sense Dev server and they MUST be reviewed after Qlik Sense upgrades. The Prod environment remains in the standard configuration.

Changing Qlik Sense QMC

Follow the steps below to change the QMC interface:

1. Access the Qlik Sense server;
2. Go to the folder **C:\Program Files\Qlik\Sense\Client;**
3. Back up **qmc.css** file and rename it as **qmc - Original.css;**
4. Open the **qmc.css** file in the Notepad. It might be necessary to edit the file as administrator;
5. Search for **qmc-toolbar {;**
6. A similar block of code like this should be found (check table below);
7. Inside the **qmc-toolbar {** block, search for the property **background-color:** and change the default color by the desired color such as **#FBA235** (colors are in hexadecimal code);
8. Save and close the file;
9. Go to your machine, open QMC and press Ctrl + F5 to update the file in your machine;
10. The expected result is presented below.

Changing Qlik Sense HUB

Follow the steps below to change the HUB interface:

1. Access the Qlik Sense server;
2. Go to the folder **C:\Program Files\Qlik\Sense\Client\hub;**
3. Back up **hub.css** file and rename it as **hub- Original.css;**

4. Open the **hub.css** file in the Notepad. It might be necessary to edit the file as administrator;
5. Search for **.hub-toolbar{**;
6. A similar block of code like this should be found (check table below);
7. Inside the **.hub-toolbar{** block, search for the property **background:** and change the default color by the desired color such as **#FBA235** (colors are in hexadecimal code);
8. Save and close the file;
9. Go to your machine, open HUB and press Ctrl + F5 to update the file in your machine;
10. The expected result is presented below.
