

Qlik® Sense 2.0.2 – Release notes

Bug fixes

Qlik Sense 2.0.2 includes the bug fixes for Qlik Sense 2.0.1. For details on these fixes, please refer to the Release Notes for that particular release:

- 1. Navigate to www.qlik.com and then select Support > Download.
- 2. On the **Qlik® Sense** tab, filter on the **Product** (Qlik Sense Enterprise or Qlik Sense Desktop) and the **Version No** (2.0.1) and then select to download the applicable Release note from the **Downloads** section.

Qlik Sense 2.0.2 delivers fixes for the issues described below.

Bar charts incorrectly resized

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36416, QLIK-34292

When a previously made selection had been deselected, bar charts did in some cases not resize correctly.

Table relationship recommendations not working as expected

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36417, QLIK-33306

The Table relationship recommendations drop-down list in the Add Data dialog did not display as expected when unfolded.

Created and Last Modified labels missing in App Edit

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36418, QLIK-34433

The Created and Last Modified labels were missing from the App edit page in QMC.

Manual app migration will not start after failed migration

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36419, QLIK-35766

If migration of an app failed, the app could not manually be upgraded from the QMC.

Selections in global search not working as expected

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36420, QLIK-33058

If no selections had been applied to an app, it was not possible to make selections using Smart Search.

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New memory allocated every time the same app is opened in Desktop

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36478, QLIK-35101

When opening several instances of the same large app in Qlik Sense Desktop, new memory was allocated for each instance.

Publish by replacing merges app content for a short while

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36479, QLIK-35666

If you published a new version by replacing an existing app while this app was open, it could briefly appear that the apps were merged.

Updated system requirements

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36848

System requirements updated to state that.NET 4.5.2 requires Windows 7 SP1 and Windows Server 2008 R2 SP1.

Multinode: QES restarted unexpectedly

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36641, QLIK-23082

When many users consume the same app and create personal content, while continuous reloads of the app are performed in the background, the Qlik Sense Engine Service could unexpectedly restart.

Log file missing some fields

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36834, QLIK-35804

Due to timing issues, log files could appear to be missing some fields if the file handle was made available before it was ready.

Different content in apps depending on Engine used

Jira issue ID: QLIK-36837, QLIK-32805

If synchronization hung because of network issues, repository data may differ between the nodes.

Known issues and limitations


The following issues and limitations were identified at release time. The list is not comprehensive; it does however list all known major issues and limitations. The ambition is to have the issues fixed in coming versions.

Migration service cannot establish web socket to Engine

In some cases, App Migration may not work because the Migration service cannot establish a websocket connection to the Qlik Engine.

Workaround:

- 1. Depending on the scenario:
 - If you are installing Qlik Sense: Uncheck the "Start the Qlik Sense services when the setup is complete" checkbox during the installation.



- If installation already has been performed: Stop all Qlik Sense services.
- 2. Start all services except the Dispatcher service.
- 3. Make sure you can access the Hub and the apps to verify that the Engine is running.
- 4. Start the Dispatcher service.
- 5. Access QMC and import/migrate apps again.
