9.0 SR3 Update New Build - 7440

Since the release of QV9.00 SR3 build 7436 we have identified five bugs that we think are serious enough to upgrade the version that is available on the download site.

Build 7436 is still a supported build and QT Support can provide the relevant download links if necessary, but for most build 7440 will be a better choice. The following bugs have been fixed between build 7436 and build 7440:

Bug ID Title

25276 Performance optimizations for handling many small requests in the server (*)

25798 Error exporting document layout

25803 Open URL does not work in the plugin

25829 Cannot run QlikView Server on Domain Controller

25907 Ctrl + Select in Multibox - Ajax SR3 - Connection Lost

(*) The manifestation of this bug is that certain types of pivot boxes fail to work or force a server disconnect.

This SR contains a number of fixes to QlikView, QlikView Server and clients and QlikView Publisher. See attached release notes for details.

Announcement - QlikView 10 and Java Client

When QlikView 10 goes GA in October 2010, it will ship without the Java client. Simply put, we are eliminating the Java client with QV10. The decision to eliminate the Java client comes for several reasons:

- Very few customers use the Java client.
- The AJAX client is a more fully featured client than the Java client in QlikView 10. Given the Java client runs in a browser, and so does the AJAX client, it is redundant to have two browser clients -- especially since the Java client lacks performance and features of the AJAX client. The interactivity of AJAX has now surpassed the Java client
- The Java client introduces another layer of security risk that we eliminate if we focus on the AJAX client. Again, given both run in the browser, there is little value to this additional layer
- It is very costly for QlikTech to maintain the Java client, especially in light of it's limited use

While we plan to eliminate the Java client, two important capabilities are NOT being eliminated. First, is Java as an API on which to extend and build on QlikView. We will continue to support the JavaBeans infrastructure for interoperation between QlikView and J2EE application servers. Second, the Java client for mobile phones (JME), including Blackberry. In fact, by eliminating the Java CLIENT, we leave significantly more resources to focus on these two important areas.

If you have feedback on this change, please leave a comment to this blog entry and/or contact your representative at QlikTech. The number one reason for sharing this change now, is to elicit feedback from our community while there is still time to modify QlikView 10.

We recently made QlikView 9.0 SR6 available for general consumption. This service release contains many updates (documented in the attached release notes) that cover QDS clustering and an important update to the behavior of Session CALs, setting a minimum timeout at 15 minutes. The SR6 installation packages for Server and Publisher that were initially published 2 weeks ago contained an incorrect JavaScript file that made it impossible to open multiple documents with the Ajax client (bug 33166). If you experience these types of problems, please contact QlikTech Support for patch instructions. The issue has now been rectified. The SR6 installation packages that are now available for download do NOT have this problem.

As we move towards more frequent releases of version updates, QlikTech R&D have decided to release an **Update** for version 10 SR1 for QlikView Desktop. The build number for this release is 10.00.8815.

What is the difference between a Customer Patch, an Update and a Service Release?

All releases are incremental and will include all code changes implemented after the previous Service Release. However the release and testing cycle differs between the different types of releases:

- **Customer Patch** - the most basic release and generally not rigorously tested. Generally aimed at fixing a particular *production critical* issue affecting a customer
- **Update** - basic testing is completed on the code changes implemented. Generally issue(s) which may affect more than one customer
- **Service Release** - full comprehensive testing cycle completed including full regression testing

The element of risk when using the different types of releases will differ. Customer Patches by their nature have a greater chance of unintended issues than Updates and the least risk applies to using a Service Release.

This "Update" only affects QlikView Desktop. If you have experienced any of the problems below and would like a copy of this release, please log a case through the [Customer Portal](#) or [Partner Portal](#), respectively.

Bugs fixed in this release:

- Bug 35328: Developer crashes when creating charts with cyclic group
- Bug 35369: QlikView Desktop crashes when creating a bar chart with drill down group
- Bug 35363: "Unexpected Exception occurred" when adding a drill down group
- Bug 35341: QV Windows lost focus by editing Drilldown Groups
- Bug 35330: Clicking OK when editing Dimension Cycle Group hangs QlikView Developer, no exception generated

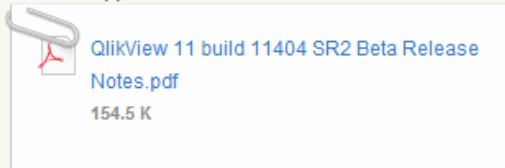

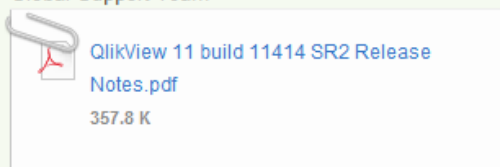
