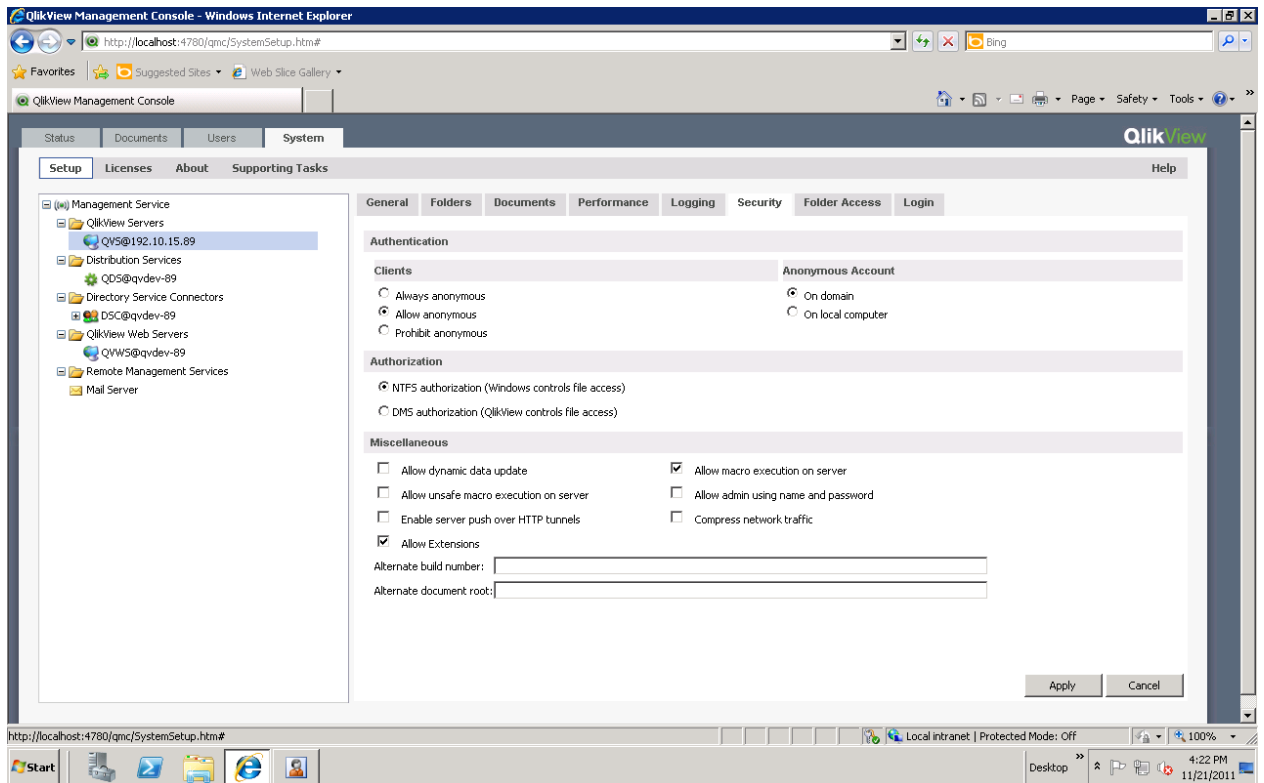
1. Testing Done on:

- QlikView Server 11 IR
- Apple iOS 5.0.1(9A405)
- Safari Browser for Apple
- Mozilla Firefox (8.0) for Android Devices

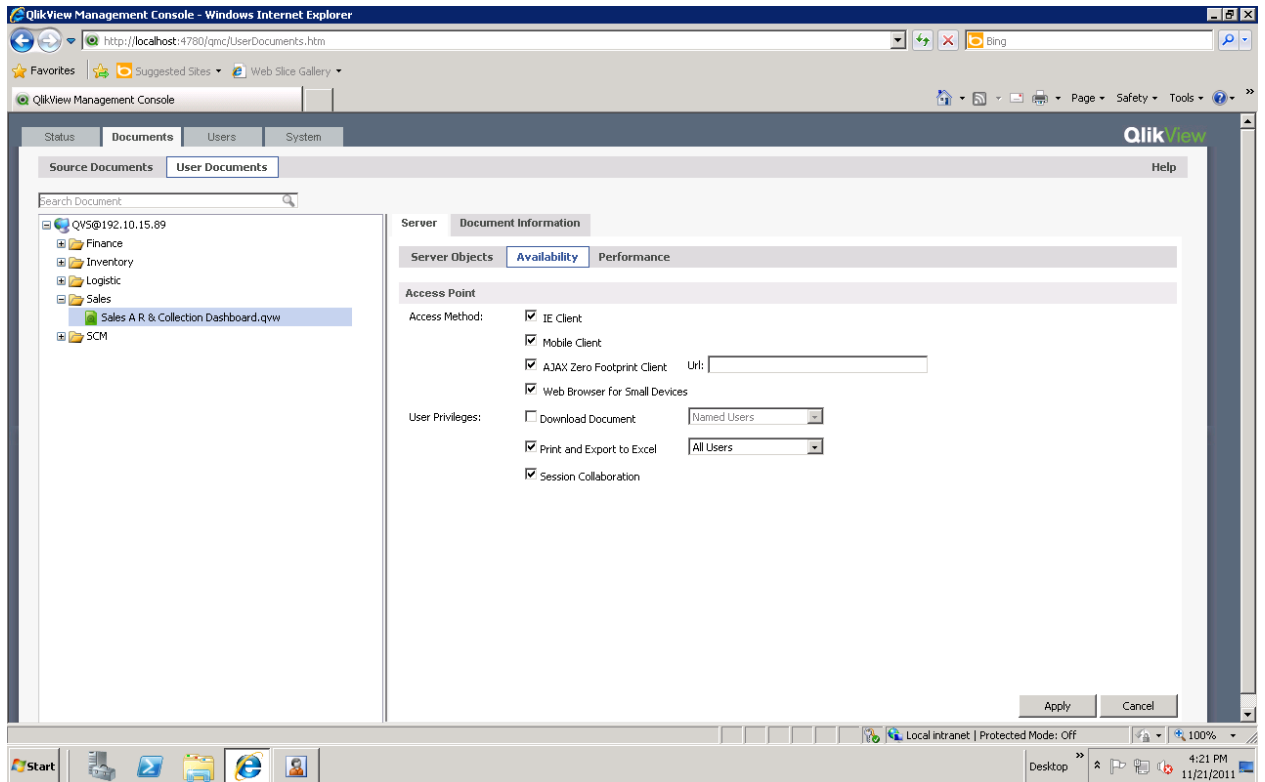
2. Settings to be made in QEMC:

The settings in QEMC are required, whether we use iPhone or Android based mobile device to access QV application.

- System→Setup→Select QlikView Servers→Security→
Uncheck “Always Anonymous”, Check “Allow Anonymous” or “Prohibit anonymous”, Check “On Domain” and “NTFS authorization”. Click Apply.



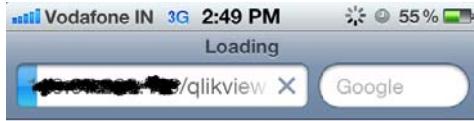
- Documents→User Documents→Select Application to access on Smart Device→Availability→Check “Mobile Client”, “AJAX Zero Foot Print Client” & “Web Browser for Small Devices”. Click Apply.



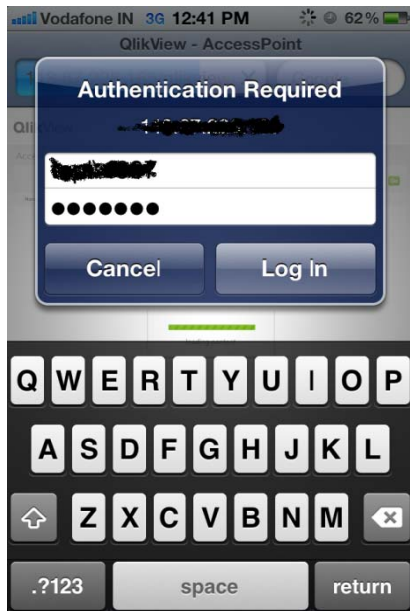
- Leave the rest of the settings as it is.

3. Accessing QV Access Point on iPhone / iPad (Safari Browser)

- Open the Safari Browser on iPhone / iPad.
- Enter Web address on Safari Browser enter as <http://myServer/qlikview> .

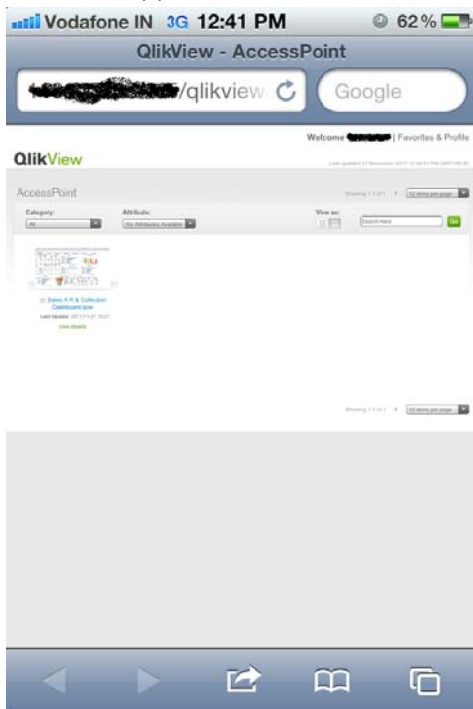


- Enter Server User Name and Password in the dialog box.

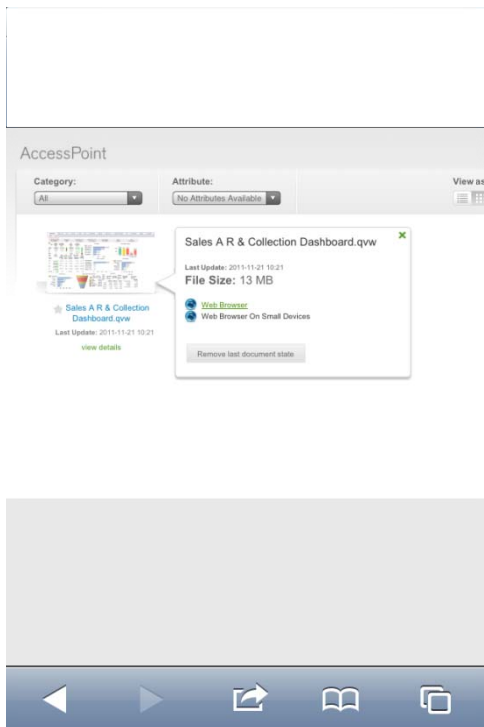


(QlikView Access Point Web page will be opened after successful login)

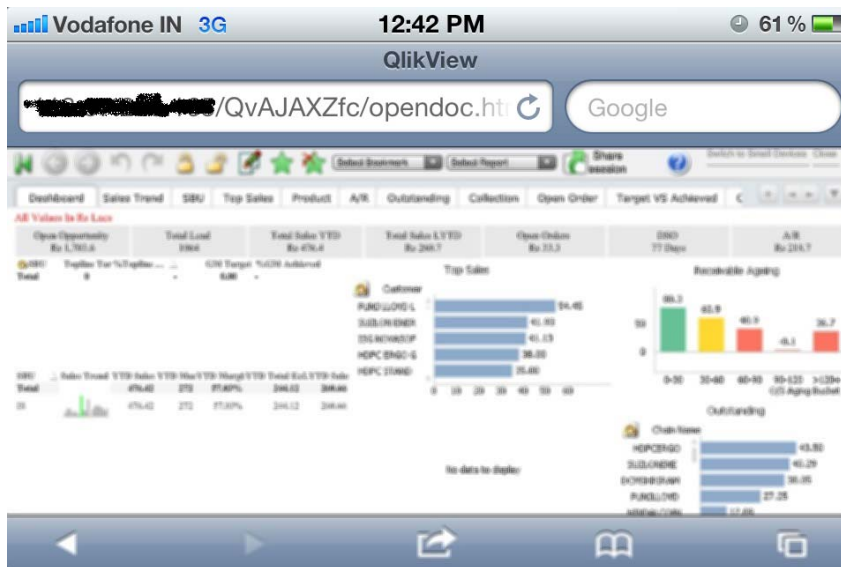
- Select the application.



- Click on **view details** below the application name, Click on Web Browser in the application details. (User should be added in the section access if the application has section access in order to access the application.)



- Application will be opened.



4. Accessing QV Access Point on Android based Mobile devices

- Install Mozilla Firefox 8.0 on your Android Smart Phone.
- Go to Browser Settings → Check Java Script ON & Check Allow Cookies.
- Enter Web address on Mozilla Firefox (8.0) browser as <http://myServer/qlikview>.
- Enter Server User Name and Password in the dialog box.
(QlikView Access Point Web page will be opened after successful login)
- Select the application.
- Click on **view details** below the application name → Click on “Web Browser” in the application details. (User should be added in the section access if the application has section access in order to access the application)
- Application will be opened.

5. Note:

- Server only on Public IP can be accessed on smart device with 3G or EDGE.
- Servers not on public IP can be accessed only when server and smart device are on same network.
- iPhone / iPad firmware version should be 3.0 or later.
- Java Script should be ON in Safari Settings as well as in Mozilla Firefox.
- Accept Cookies should be selected as "Always".
