Resolution

This function is implemented since version 10 SR 4 (10.00.9282):

Note: This change will affect all users of the Ajax client!

Settings.ini:

- On the QlikView Server open settings.ini for edit. Backup settings.ini before making any changes. The file can be found in the following location:

Windows Server 2008: C:\ProgramData\QlikTech\QlikViewServer\Settings.ini

Windows Server 2003: C:\Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\QlikTech\QlikViewServer\settings.ini

- stop all QlikView services

- In the [Settings 7] section in settings.ini, create the setting ShowRefreshDoc=1

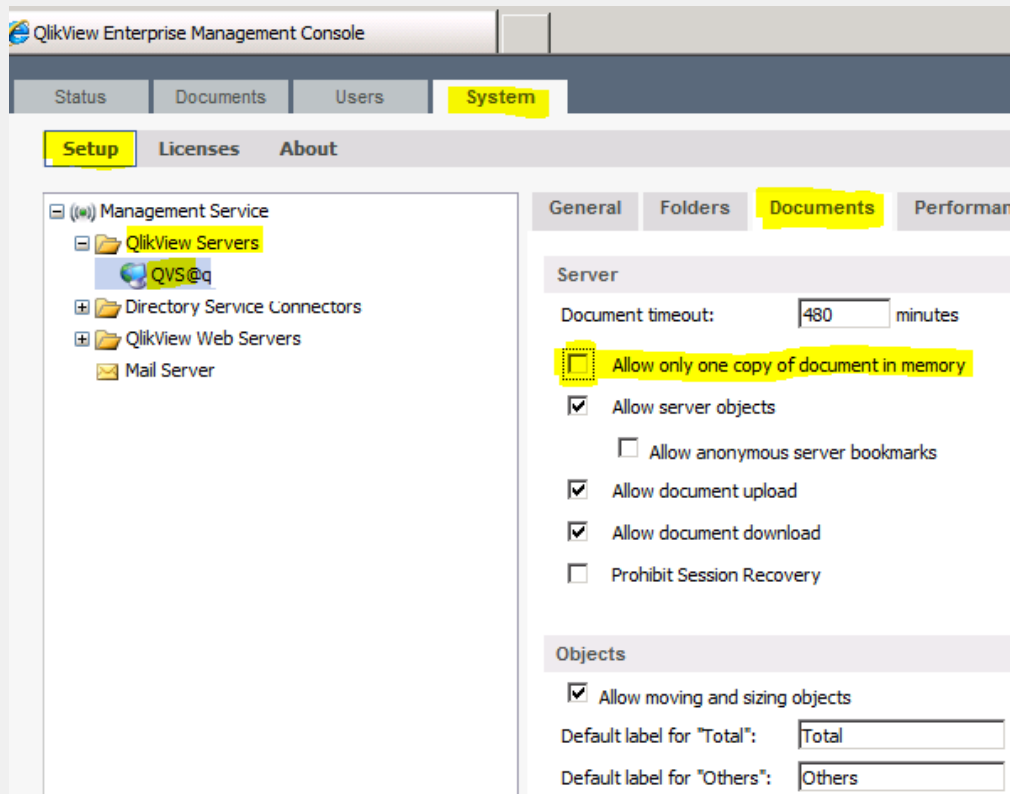
Note: Make sure the setting is added after [Settings 7] but before any other section marker [...]

- Save settings.ini

QlikView Enterprise Management Console:

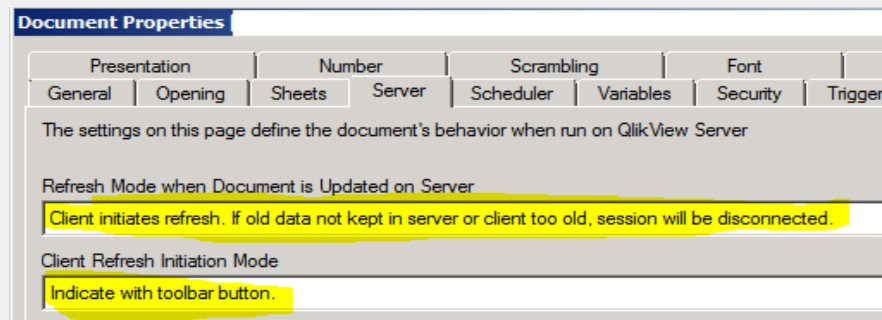
- System > Setup > QlikView Server - QVS@... > Documents > disable "Allow only one copy of

document in memory



QlikView Desktop - *.qvw:

- In the original document,
- Document Properties > Server
 - > set Refresh Mode to "Client initiates refresh. If old data not kept in server or client too old, session will be disconnected"
 - > Client Refresh Initiation Mode to "Indicate with toolbar button"



Then open application on AccessPoint and in the toolbar you see this function:



Tags QlikView Server, AJAX, Client initials refresh, Allow only one copy of document in memory, Client initiates refresh, If old data not kept in server or client too old, session will be disconnected, Indicate with toolbar button, Desktop, settings.ini
